Vet. (10,2)

1st. Tomlinson & Keight's Ch. Rainesgift Seymour BVD & BV in show. 8yrs old. Good head and ear set and reach of neck. Well laid shoulders with good angulation. Straight front with well boned legs and tight feet. Coat in good condition with plenty of feathering. Moved well.

2nd. Slack's Spera Thalia Lazio. 9yrs old. Good head and reach of neck going to well placed shoulders. A little weight on shoulders doesn't detract from his good movement. Good coat and feathering.

3rd. Green's Hertarns Dr. Pepper

Sp.Vet.(2)

1st. Salt's Sumaha Rainmaker at Wetnoses 10¼yrs old. Still looking good for age. Well shaped head and good reach of neck. Good bone and tight feet. Moved well.

2nd. Knight's Gemswin Let Me Entertain You 13yrs old. This dog has been a consistant winner during his career. Still looking good and enjoying his showing. Movement let him down today.

MPD (7)

1st. Holland's Flatcharm Wild Thing. BPD. Good head with nice shaped, dark eye. Well arched neck leading to well placed shoulders. Good angulation and nice bone and tight feet. Good coat and feathering for one so young. Moved well.

2nd. Ashcroft & Long's Canalhouse Top Suit to Keepersway. Typical head with dark, well shaped eye. Good reach of neck with well placed shoulders. Level topline with well set on tail. Still some maturing to do. Moved well.

3rd. Harris's Marjosi Springtime Charmer.

1st. Holland's Flatcharm Wild Thing As 1st. in MPD.

2nd. Jacob & Holmes' Gemswin Nites in White Satin. Good head and reach of neck leading to well placed shoulders. Good angulation , well boned legs and tight feet. Level topline and well set wagging tail. Nicely bent stifles with plenty of muscle. In good coat and feathering. Moved well.

3rd. Tinker's Wainhawke Othello.

Jun.D.(6)

1st. Broadbent's Hallbent October Toccata. Well shaped, masculine head with dark almond eye and good ear set. Nice reach of neck and well placed

shoulders. Plenty of bone with tight feet. Good tail set and coat in good condition. Moved well.

2nd. Romeo-Dieste Hopevalley Morning Mayhem JW. Nice head and eye with good ear set. good reach of neck leading to well placed shoulders. Well boned with tight feet. Moved well Good coat and feathering.

3rd. Squire & Oliver's Pajanbeck Black Velvet with Bramstorm

Yearling D. (8,1)

1st. Harris' Steelriver Heat of the Night. Took my eye as he entered the ring. Good head and dark eye with nice reach of neck. Plenty of bone, well placed shoulders and good angulations. Tight feet. Level topline and well set tail. Coat in good condition but lacking much feathering at the moment. This will come with maturity. Moved well with drive.

2nd. Knight, Jacobs & Homes' Broomsward Hugo Boss by Gemswin. Another youngster looking for top honours in the future. Nice head, eye and ear set. Good reach of neck leading to well placed shoulders and good angulations. Plenty of bone and tight feet. Coat in good condition and well feathered. Moved well with happy wagging tail.

3rd. Mee's Lamintone All Out Rouge.

Nov. D. (10)

1st. Burroughs' Elmstock Echoes of Thyme over Rokaness. Nice head and good reach of neck going to well placed shoulders. Good bone and carrying level topline. Nice bend of stifle. Coat well feathered. Moved well.

2nd. Gulbis' Gayplume Vital Spark. Good head and neck. Well placed shoulders with level topline. Good tight feet. Well feathered coat, Moved well.

3rd. Broadbent's Hallbent October Toccata.

Grad. D. (14,2)

1st. Hills' Branchalwood Benrioch at Lindisfarne. 1 & 2 litter brothers, will change places many times. Mature for age. Good head and neck. Well placed shoulders and good angulation. Well boned with tight feet. Level topline and well set tail. Good feathering. Moved well with happy wagging tail.

2nd. Strudwick's Branchalwood Balmenach for Burpham JW ShCM. Same Comments as 1 but slightly less mature. Presented in immaculate condition. Moved well.

3rd. Nicholls' Llantrussa Eton Mess with Lineover.

P.Grad.D. (9)

1st. Hills' Branchalwood Benrioch at Lindisfarne. As 1st. in Grad. D.

2nd. Collins' Steeplehouse Dance in Thyme. Liked this dog as a puppy, now maturing into a very nice adult. Slightly finer boned than 1. Good head and neck going to well placed shoulders. Level topline carried on the move. Good coat and feathering. Moved well.

3rd. Winton's Braidwynn Bennigan.

Lim.D. (19,3)

1st. Wisbey & Eaton's Shiredale Meadow Saffron in Hazlemere. CC & BIS. Beautiful mature dog, full of class. Typical head with correct dark eye and ear set. Good reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Well boned legs with tight feet. Level topline kept on the move. In good coat and plenty of feathering. Moved well with drive. Pleased to see Referee award him Best in Show.

2nd. Pingree's Castlerock Stormy Knight over Heatheridge JW ShCM. Lovely head, reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Plenty bone, tight feet. Well presented in good condition. Moved well with exuberance.

3rd. Ashcroft & Long's Beanit Ned Kelly to Keepersway.

Op.D. (9,3)

1st. Brady's Llantrussa Head over Heels to Bordercot RCC. Well shaped head with dark almond eye. Nice reach of neck with well placed shoulders. Good construction front and rear. Plenty of bone and tight feet. Level topline kept on the move. Moved well with drive. Presented in immaculate condition.

2nd. Ross' Islstrom Quillan JW. Good head and kind dark eye. Good reach of neck going to well laid shoulders. Good bone and tight feet. Profuse coat with plenty of feathering. Moved well with happy wagging tail.

3rd. Holland's Calzeat Causa Commotion at Flatcharm (Imp)

Sp.Liv.D.(5)

1st. Knight' Jacobs & Holmes' Gemswin Son Of A Preacherman with Candidacasa JW. Good head and correctly shaped eye. Dark liver with dark pigmentation. Good reach of neck going to well laid shoulders. Level topline going to ever wagging tail. Coat in good condition but lacking feathering today. Moved well with drive.

2nd. Colson's Windyhollows Brere Bear. Slightly lighter liver with pigmentation to match. Typical head with almond eye and good ear placement. Good reach of neck going to well placed shoulders and level topline. Well boned and tight feet. Coat in good condition. Moved well.

3rd. Huckle's Gayplume Fly by Night.

1st. Colson's Windyhollows Brere Bear. As 2nd. in Liver Dog.

2nd. Tinker's Wainhawke Othello. 3rd. in puppy dog. Nice head and eye. Good reach of neck. Plenty bone, good coat. moved well.
